ORDINANCE NO. 2000-12 REGULATING AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF TOWN BOARD SUPERVISORS

The Town Board of the Town of Deerfield, Dane County, Wisconsin, DO ORDAIN as follows:

Ordinance No. 2000-12 shall be created to read as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to the authorization granted to towns by sec. 60.21 (1), Wis. Stats. The Town Board of the Town of Deerfield hereby increase the number of town board supervisors to five.
- 2. The board will consist of one Chairperson and four additional Supervisors.
- 3. Two Supervisors and Chairperson shall be elected in odd-number years and two Supervisors shall be elected in even-numbered years. Therefore, the Chairperson and two Supervisors receiving the highest number of votes in the next election shall serve two year terms, and the other two Supervisors elected shall serve one-year initial terms. Each subsequent election shall before two-year terms so that elections occur in both odd-numbered and even-numbered years.

The Town Board DO FURTHER ORDAIN that this Ordinance shall be effective following its adoption, posting and/or publication.
