ORDINANCE NO. 98-8 REGULATING SPEED LIMITS WITHIN THE TOWN OF DEERFIELD

WHEREAS, The Town of Deerfield has determined upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that the statutory speed limit on certain Town Highways is greater than is reasonable or safe under conditions found to exist upon those Town Highways;

THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF DEERFIELD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: That the Town of Deerfield determines and declares that the following speed limits are reasonable and safe on the sections of Town Highways listed below and declares them to be the maximum legal speed limits for the following sections of those Town Highways:

Oak Park Road from USH 12 & 18 north to the intersection with CTH BB. Maximum Speed Limit shall be 45 MPH.

London Road from West Main Street 1500 feet West. Maximum Speed Limit shall be 35 MPH.

Liberty Road from the intersection of STH 73 west 0.4 miles (the far west limits of the Village of Deerfield).

Maximum Speed Limit shall be 25 MPH.

Liberty Road from a point 0.4 miles west of the intersection with STH 73 to a point 0.65 miles west of the intersection of STH 73 in the Town of Deerfield.

Maximum Speed Limit shall be 35 MPH.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the appropriate signs giving notice of such speed limits shall be erected and put in place.

The Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law.
