

**TOWN OF DEERFIELD
TOWN BOARD MEETING
August 13, 2018**

Chairperson Schlobohm called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. at the Deerfield Town Garage. Those in attendance were: Chairperson Mike Schlobohm, Supervisors Nick Brattlie, Bill Roelofs, Randy Behlke, Clerk Robin Untz and Treasurer Korby Holzhueter. Supervisor Dan Kelly

Approval of Agenda: Motion made by Sup. Behlke to approve the amended agenda as posted, seconded by Sup. Brattlie. Motion carried.

Approval of Minutes: Sup. Behlke motioned to approve the previous month's minutes, seconded by Sup. Roelofs. Motion carried.

Reports: Al Pulvermacher the Hwy patrolman reported that the crack filling and seal coat projects are complete.

Public Comment: Pashia and Jer Thao, property owners on Hwy 73 requested that the garbage service fee that has been assessed on their vacant property be removed until a new home is built. Treasurer Korby Holzhueter noted to take the fee of the general tax roll for 2018.

It was also noted that the road sign for Deer Lake Road has been installed.

Adoption of the amended Building Code Ordinance: Motion made by Chairperson Schlobohm Sup. to adopt the amended Building Code Ordinance, seconded by Supervisor Roeloffs. Motion Carried.

Motion made by Sup. Brattlie to approve the road bid for Chip Seal from Fahrner Asphalt for \$92,813, seconded by Sup. Behlke. Chairperson Schlobohm abstained from voting. Motion Carried.

Discussion/Action of possible amendment to Driveway Ordinance for regulation of vegetation along driveways: Discussion postponed until the Plan Commission discusses it and makes a recommendation.

Discussion/Action of proposed excavation in the road right of way by Alliant Energy on Olstad and Oak Park Rds. Discussion postponed until Kevin Doyle of Alliant Energy prepares an written agreement with the town in regards to the project. Al Pulvermacher the Hwy Patrolman will contact Mr. Doyle.

Discussion/Action of proposed bike trail. Discussion postponed until as requested by Supervisor Roeloffs.

Discussion/Action of review of information discussed at the meeting with Village of Deerfield and Town of Cottage Grove of possible shared services opportunities. No action. It was reported that the Town of Cottage Grove set up a joint meeting for the municipalities on Sept 6, 2018 at 6:30pm at the Town of Cottage Grove Town Hall. Meeting will be posted for Town of Deerfield officials to attend.
