MONTHLY MEETING, DECEMBER 14, 2020, 7:00 P.M., MONDAY

CHAIRMAN MIKE SCHLOBOHM CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER WITH ALL OFFICERS IN ATTENDANCE.

ON A MOTION BY RANDY BEHLKE, SECONDED BY BILL ROELOFS, A MOTION WAS MADE FOR THE MEETING AGENDA ADOPTION. MOTION CARRIED

ON A MOTION BY RANDY BEHLKE, SECONDED BY MIKE SCHLOBOHM, A MOTION WAS MADE TO ADOPT THE NOVEMBER MEETING MINUTES. MOTION CARRIED.

ON A MOTION BY NICK BRATTLIE, SECONDED BY DAN KELLY, A MOTION WAS MADE TO ADOPT THE 2021 BUDGET MEETING MINUTES. MOTION CARRIED.

DAN KELLY SUGGESTED THE BOARD SEND A GET WELL CARD TO KIM GROB WITH ALL THE NAMES OF THE BOARD AND EMPLOYEES. THE CLERK WAS REQUESTED TO DO SO.

PUBLIC COMMENTS CENTERED AROUND JIM MAPLE EXPLAINING SOME REWRITING OF CHAPTERS 1 & 2 OF THE MINING ORDINANCE.

ON A MOTION BY NICK BRATTLIE, SECONDED BY RANDY BEHLKE, A MOTION WAS MADE TO PASS REZONE PETITION NO. 11629 FOR WES HALVERSON TO REZONE 2 ACRES FOR A RESIDENTIAL BUILDING SITE. MOTION CARRIED.

ON A MOTION BY BILL ROELOFS, SECONDED BY MIKE SCHLOBOHM, A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE ASSESSOR CONTRACTS OF \$8800.00 FOR 2021 AND \$12000.00 FOR 2022 WERE TO BE ACCEPTED. MOTION CARRIED.

A MOTION WAS MADE TO ACCEPT ORDINANCE AMENDMENT 2020-5 MINING FEES. ROLL CALL VOTE: ROELOFS, BEHLKE, BRATTLIE----AYE KELLY----NO SCHLOBOHM----ABSTAIN MOTION CARRIED.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY BILL ROELOFS FOR A PARTIAL REFUND TO FOREVER SAND AND GRAVEL, OAK PARK RD. QUARRY, WHICH WOULD REFLECT THE LESSER COSTS OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE FEE IN THE APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL IN THE UPCOMING YEAR. MOTION DIED DUE TO LACK OF A SECOND.

THE 5-7 YEAR ROAD MAINTENANCE PLAN PROPOSAL WAS TABLED.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY DAN KELLY, SECONDED BY MIKE SCHLOBOHM, TO ACCEPT THE TREASURER'S REPORT. MOTION CARRIED.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY RANDY BEHLKE, SECONDED BY NICK BRATTLIE, TO ACCEPT THE GENERAL FUND VOUCHER OF \$72,026.86. MOTION CARRIED.

THE BOARD WAS MADE AWARE OF THE POTENTIAL PROBLEM OF CONTAMINATED SOILS AT THE ABANDONED LONDON FERTILIZER PLANT. MIKE SCHLOBOHM WOULD KEEP TRACK OF FUTURE CORRESPONDENCE.

ERIC LANG, EMS CHIEF FOR DEER-GROVE EMS, WAS PRESENT TO DISCUSS THE CREATION OF A COMMISSION FOR STUDYING FUTURE PERSONNEL NEEDS AND THE REQUEST TO HAVE A TOWN OFFICIAL AS A COMMISSION MEMBER.

ABANDONMENT OF A SHORT TOWN ROAD OFF N. FAIR OAK RD. WAS TABLED AS NO RESIDENTS OF THE DRIVE WERE PRESENT AND BOTH PARTIES WOULD HAVE TO BE IN AGREEMENT FOR THE ROAD TO BE VACATED.
