

TOWN OF DEERFIELD

MONTHLY MEETING, MONDAY, APRIL 12, 2021, 7:00 P.M., DCC CENTER

CHAIRMAN MIKE SCHLOBOHM CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AT 7:02 P.M. WITH ALL OFFICERS IN ATTENDANCE.

ON A MOTION BY BILL ROELOFS, SECONDED BY MIKE SCHLOBOHM THE BOARD ACCEPTED THE AGENDA. MOTION CARRIED.

ON A MOTION BY BILL ROELOFS, SECONDED BY NICK BRATTLIE, THE BOARD ACCEPTED THE MARCH MINUTES. MOTION CARRIED.

ON A MOTION BY RANDY BEHLKE, SECONDED BY NICK BRATTLIE, THE BOARD ACCEPTED A BID FROM PAYNE & DOLAN FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION OF OAK PARK ROAD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$627,517.50 TO BE COMPLETED IN 2021. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

ON A MOTION BY BILL ROELOFS, SECONDED BY RANDY BEHLKE, THE BOARD AGREED TO REFUND FOREVER SAND & GRAVEL, OAK PARK QUARRY, \$1660.00 FROM ADMINISTRATIVE FEES COLLECTED FOR 2021 WHICH WERE NOT USED FOR THE APPLICATION REVIEW. RANDY BEHLKE, BILL ROELOFS, AND NICK BRATTLIE VOTED IN FAVOR OF THE REFUND. DAN KELLY VOTED AGAINST. MIKE SCHLOBOHM ABSTAINED.

THE DEER-GROVE EMS COMMISSION IS CURRENTLY STUDYING THE POSSIBLE NEED TO HAVE A PROFESSIONAL ORGANIZATION MAKE A RECOMMENDATION ON THE FUTURE NEEDS OF THE SERVICE FOR THE COMMUNITIES INVOLVE.

THE LIBERTY ROAD PROJECT, 2022, WILL BE READY FOR BID LETTING BY AUGUST, 2021, ACCORDING TO MID-STATES ENGINEERING.

THERE WAS A SHORT DISCUSSION ON THE KOSHKONONG SOLAR PROJECT WITH CONCERNED CITIZENS.

A DISCUSSION WAS HELD REGARDING THE STANDARDS FOR THE TOWN'S TDR POLICIES AND THE DANE COUNTY ZONING DEPT. PERCIVED DIFFERENCES IN THOSE POLICIES. IT WAS STATED THAT ANY TDR REQUEST SHOULD BE ABSOLUTELY INITIATED AT THE TOWN LEVEL.

ON A MOTION BY MIKE SCHLOBOHM, SECONDED BY BILL ROELOFS THE BOARD WOULD ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE DEERFIELD COMMUNITY CENTER FOR THE UTILIZATION OF THEIR PHYSICAL MEETING ROOM FOR MEETINGS FOR A 20 YEAR TERM THROUGH 2041. MOTION CARRIED.

ON A MOTION BY NICK BRATTLIE, SECONDED BY RANDY BEHLKE, THE BOARD AGREED TO ACCEPT THE TREASURER'S REPORT AND A GENERAL FUND VOUCHER OF \$38,738.88. MOTION CARRIED.

DISCUSSION WAS HELD REGARDING THE REPLACEMENT OF "DEAD END" SIGNS WITH A SIGN LOCATED AT THE TOP OF ROAD SIGNS STATING "NO OUTLET".

FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS: ZONING ISSUES, KOSHKONONG SOLAR PROJECT, OAK PARK RD. AND LIBERTY ROAD PROJECT UPDATES, DEER-GROVE EMS.
