MONTHLY MEETING, MAY 10, 2021, 7:00 P.M., DCC CENTER, 10 LIBERTY ST.

MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 7:00 P.M. BY CHAIRMAN MIKE SCHLOBOHM WITH ALL OFFICERS PRESENT EXCEPT FOR SUPERVISOR RANDY BEHLKE.

ON A MOTION BY NICK BRATTLIE, SECONDED BY KATIE MICHEL, THE AGENDA WAS ADOPTED WITH THE SWITCHING OF DATES BETWEEN ITEMS 9 AND 10 AS A CLERICAL ERROR HAD BEEN MADE. MOTION CARRIED.

JIM MAPLE GAVE A SHORT PRESENTATION AND HANDOUT REGARDING THE APPROVED METHOD OF THE PROCESS INVOLVED WITH THE TRANSFER OF DEVELOPMENT RIGHTS.

ON A MOTION BY MIKE SCHLOBOHM, SECONDED BY DAN KELLY, THE BOARD GRANTED A CLASS "B" BEER LICENSE AND CLASS "C" WINE LICENSE TO DONALD AND THERESA SCHUSTER FOR THEIR FARM, 1326 HWY. 12 & 18. MOTION CARRIED.

ON A MOTION BY NICK BRATTLIE, SECONDED BY MIKE SCHLOBOHM, THE BOARD GRANTED THE PROPOSED LOT LINE CHANGES FOR CSM #15427, BRUCE GJERMO. MOTION CARRIED.

THE BOARD EXPRESSED NO CONCERNS OR OBJECTIONS THUS FAR WITH TDR PROJECTS BY CODY EILENFELDT, NULAND RD. AND DAVID DINKEL REPRESENTING A PARCEL TDR RIGHT TO BE TRANSFERRED BY THOMAS SCHALLER.

A PRESENTATION WAS MADE REGARDING THE DEER-GROVE EMS SUBMITTING A PROPOSAL FOR COMPANIES TO BID ON THE STUDY FOR THE FUTURE NEEDS OF THE DEER-GROVE EMS WITH THE INTENT OF HAVING RECOMMENDATIONS MADE BY FALL FOR FUTURE BUDGETING PURPOSES.

THE LIBERTY ROAD PROJECT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE AND TOWNSHIP WOULD BE READY FOR BIDDING BY AUGUST WITH A STARTING AND COMPLETION DATE IN 2022.

THE OAK PARK ROAD PROJECT HAS A SIGNED CONTRACT WITH WORK SLATED TO BEGIN BY SUMMER, 2021, WITH A COMPLETION DATE DURING THE SUMMER.

OTHER ROAD MAINTENANCE PROJECTS WOULD BE DECIDED ON AT A LATER DATE WHEN AVAILABLE FUNDING WOULD BE MORE ACCURATELY DETERMINED.

ON A MOTION BY NICK BRATTLIE, SECONDED BY KATIE MICHEL, THE BOARD ACCEPTED THE TREASURER'S REPORT AND A GENERAL FUND VOUCHER BALANCE OF \$186,009.71. MOTION CARRIED.
