JULY MONTHLY MINUTES, MONDAY, JULY 12, 2021, 7:00 P.M., DCC CENTER

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MIKE SCHLOBOHM AT 7:00 P.M. WITH ALL OFFICERS IN ATTENDANCE.

ON A MOTION BY RANDY BEHLKE, SECONDED BY MIKE SCHLOBOHM, THE BOARD ADOPTED THE MEETING AGENDA. MOTION CARRIED.

ON A MOTION BY NICK BRATTLIE, SECONDED BY DAN KELLY, THE BOARD APPROVED THE JUNE MINUTES. MOTION CARRIED.

ON A MOTION BY MIKE SCHLOBOHM, SECONDED BY KATIE MICHEL, THE BOARD WOULD AGREE TO HELP FUND A STUDY FOR IMPROVING THE KOSHKONONG CREEK AND THE WATER CARRIED FROM SUN PRAIRIE SOUTH AND EAST TO THE JEFFERSON COUNTY LINE. THE STUDY WOULD BE DONE BY THE UNIVERCITY ALLIANCE CENTER AT A COST OF \$20,000.00 OF WHICH THE TOWN OF DEERFIELD WOULD CONTRIBUTE \$5,000.00. MOTION CARRIED.

MR. J HELLENBRAND WAS PRESENT TO PROVIDE EXAMPLES OF ATV ORDINANCES USED BY SURROUNDING MUNICIPALITIES TO ALLOW THE LEGAL USE OF TOWN ROADS FOR ATV AND UTV(S). THE TOWN OF MEDINA CURRENTLY HAS ONE THAT THE TOWN OF DEERFIELD COULD INCORPORATE AS ADJOINING MUNICIPALITIES. THE BOARD WOULD CONTINUE TO EXPLORE THE POSSIBILITY OF ADOPTION OF SUCH ORDINANCE.

THE DEER-GROVE EMS HAS STARTED THE PROCESS OF STUDYING WHERE TO BEST UPDATE ITS ORGANIZATION FOR THE FUTURE BY HIRING A CONSULTING FIRM, PUBLIC ADM. ASSOCIATES, WHITEWATER, WI.

MIKE SCHLOBOHM INFORMED THE BOARD THAT A FORTY FOOT FLAGPOLE NOT INSTALLED WOULD BE \$5,800.00. NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.

THE LIBERTY ROAD 2022 PROJECT IS STILL ON SCHEDULE TO BE BID IN AUGUST, 2021.

THE BOARD AGREED TO SOLICIT BIDS YET FOR 2021 TO DO CRACKFILLING WORK.

ON A MOTION BY NICK BRATTLIE, SECONDED BY KATIE MICHEL, THE BOARD APPROVED THE TREASURER'S REPORT AND A GENERAL FUND VOUCHER OF \$182,495.58. MOTION CARRIED.

ON A MOTION BY NICK BRATTLIE, SECONDED BY KATIE MICHEL, THE BOARD APPROVED ZONING PETITION NO. 11723 FOR CODY EILENFELDT. MOTION CARRIED.
