

TOWN OF DEERFIELD

MONTHLY MEETING, MONDAY, AUGUST 9, 2021, 7:00 P.M., DCC CENTER, 10 LIBERTY ST.

ALL OFFICERS EXCEPT SUPERVISOR DAN KELLY WERE PRESENT

ON A MOTION BY RANDY BEHLKE, SECONDED BY KATIE MICHEL, THE BOARD AGREED TO THE MEETING AGENDA. MOTION CARRIED.

ON A MOTION BY RANDY BEHLKE, SECONDED BY MIKE SCHLOBOHM, THE BOARD APPROVED THE JULY MINUTES. MOTION CARRIED.

MR. DERRICK BRELLENTHIN, REPRESENTATIVE FOR EVERLIGHT SOLAR, WAS PRESENT TO INFORM THE BOARD THAT HIS COMPANY WAS PRESENT IN THE TOWN TO INFORM POTENTIAL RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS OF SOLAR INSTALLATIONS AVAILABLE TO THEM.

ON A MOTION BY RANDY BEHLKE, SECONDED BY KATIE MICHEL, THE BOARD AGREED TO MOVE FORWARD WITH THE POTENTIAL ADOPTION OF AN ATV ORDINANCE CLOSELY FOLLOWING THE ORDINANCE OF MEDINA TOWNSHIP WITH A FEW CHANGES. MOTION CARRIED WITH THE INSTRUCTION TO HAVE JIM MAPLE REWORK THE PROPOSED ORDINANCE AND PRESENT IT TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION AND TOWN BOARD FOR FURTHER CONSIDERATION.

ERIC LANG, DEER-GROVE EMS CHIEF WAS PRESENT TO GIVE THE TOWN BOARD AN UPDATE OF THE CURRENT STUDY OF THE DEER-GROVE OPERATIONS AND FUTURE NEEDS.

THE POTENTIAL DATE FOR THE BIDDING OF THE LIBERTY ROAD PROJECT 2022 IS SCHEDULED FOR AUGUST 21, 2021.

THE TOWN BOARD DECIDED THAT THE PROPOSED CRACKFILLING PROJECTS WOULD BE DROPPED FOR 2021 AND THE BOARD WOULD INSTEAD SOLICIT BIDS FOR WEDGING AND PATCHING ON VARIOUS ROADS.

RANDY BEHLKE GAVE A SHORT REPORT ON THE PROPOSED FUNDING OF THE EXPANSION PLANS OF THE DEERFIELD LIBRARY. HIS SENTIMENT WAS THAT THE LIBRARY WAS USED BY MANY TOWN RESIDENTS. AS SUCH THE TOWN SHOULD CONSIDER HELPING WITH THE EXPANSION FUNDING. NO FURTHER ACTION WAS TAKEN.

ON A MOTION BY NICK BRATTLIE, SECONDED BY RANDY BEHLKE, THE BOARD APPROVED THE TREASURER'S REPORT WITH A GENERAL FUND VOUCHER OF \$66,507.49. MOTION CARRIED.

THE BOARD DECIDED THAT A PROPOSED FOUR LOT SUBDIVISION LOCATED OFF HIGHWAY BB SHOULD HAVE A CUL-DE-SAC PROVIDED INSTEAD OF AN EXPANDED Y TURN LOCATION.
