CONSIDERATION OF NEW GARBAGE COLLECTION CONTRACT BEGINNING 01-01-2022

SPECIAL BOARD MEETING, MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 20, 2021, 6:00 P.M., DCC CENTER, 10 LIBERTY ST.

SUPERVISOR RANDY BEHLKE CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AT 6:00 P.M. WITH SUPERVISOR KATE MICHEL PRESENT AND CHAIRMAN MIKE SCHLOBOHM AND SUPERVISOR NICK BRATTLIE ATTENDING VIA PHONE.

ON A MOTION BY RANDY BEHLKE, SECONDED BY KATE MICHEL, THE MEETING AGENDA WAS ADOPTED. MOTION CARRIED.

VARIOUS ASPECTS OF THE TWO PROPOSED GARBAGE COLLECTION CONTRACTS WERE DISCUSSED WITH REPRESENTATIVES FROM PELITTARI AND BADGERLAND. THE MAIN POINT EMPHASIZED THAT IN THE EVENT EITHER PELITTARI OR BADGERLAND SOLD THEIR ASSESTS OR EXISTING CONTRACTS TO ANOTHER COLLECTION AGENCY DURING THE FIVE YEAR TERM THE TOWN WOULD HAVE THE RIGHTS TO NEGOTIATE A NEW CONTRACT WITH A COMPANY OF THE TOWN'S CHOOSING. BOTH COMPANY REPRESENTATIVES AGREED THIS STIPULATION WOULD BE INCLUDED IN THE CONTRACT.

ON A MOTION BY NICK BRATTLIE, SECONDED BY RANDY BEHLKE, THE BOARD AGREED TO AWARD THE NEW FIVE YEAR COLLECTION CONTRACT TO BADGERLAND DISPOSAL. MOTION CARRIED.

ON A MOTION BY KATE MICHEL, SECONDED BY RANDY BEHLKE, THE MEETING WAS ADJOURNED AT 6:30 P.M. MOTION CARRIED.
