MONTHLY MEETING, DECEMBER 13, 2021, 7:00 P.M., MONDAY, DCC CENTER, 10 LIBERTY ST.

CHAIRMAN MIKE SCHLOBOHM CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AT 7:00 P.M. WITH ALL OFFICERS PRESENT.

ON A MOTION BY RANDY BEHLKE, SECONDED BY DAN KELLY, THE MEETING AGENDA WAS ADOPTED. MOTION CARRIED.

ON A MOTION BY RANDY BEHLKE, SECONDED BY MIKE SCHLOBOHM, THE NOVEMBER MONTHLY MEETING, 2022 BUDGET HEARING, AND 2022 BUDGET LEVY MEETING WERE ADOPTED. MOTION CARRIED.

REPRESENTATIVES OF EVERSTREAM WERE PRESENT TO DISCUSS THEIR PLANS ON INSTALLING A NEW FIBER OPTIC CABLE ALONG OAK PARK RD. FROM HWY. BB TO THE CELL TOWER EAST OF THE OAK PARK QUARRY. NO OBJECTIONS WERE RAISED AND APPROVAL WAS GIVEN TO START THE PROJECT.

ON CONCERNS FROM RESIDENTS ALONG NESHEIM RD. AND BLACK OAK TRL. THE TOWN DECIDED TO INSTALL ADDITIONAL SPEED LIMIT SIGNS.

ON A MOTION BY RANDY BEHLKE, SECONDED BY MIKE SCHLOBOHM, THE BOARD PASSED ZONING PETITION 11739 FOR SOLON PIERCE III TO CREATE ONE LOT OF 4.9 ACRES ON THE CORNER OF HWY. BB AND DVORAK RD. MOTION CARRIED.

THE BOARD AGREED TO FORWARD THE PROPOSED SOLAR FARM LICENSE ORDINANCE TO THEIR LEGAL COUNSEL FOR REVIEW. FINAL APPROVAL OF THE ORDINANCE IS SCHEDULED FOR THE JANUARY-FEBRUARY, 2022 TIME FRAME.

MINOR DISCUSSIONS TOOK PLACE REGARDING THE PROPOSED KOSHKONONG SOLAR FARM INCLUDING TIME FRAMES FOR OPPOSING VIEWS AND THE CURRENT STATUS OF THE FISH FARM ON STATE FARM RD.

ON A MOTION BY MIKE SCHLOBOHM, SECONDED BY DAN KELLY, THE BOARD APPROVED A LIST OF QUALIFIED ELECTION WORKERS FOR THE UPCOMING ELECTION SEASON. MOTION CARRIED.

ON A MOTION BY NICK BRATTLIE, SECONDED BY KATIE MICHEL, THE BOARD ACCEPTED THE TREASURER'S REPORT AND A GENERAL FUND VOUCHER OF \$98,335.83. MOTION CARRIED.

MIKE SCHLOBOHM INFORMED THE BOARD OF A FUTURE D.O.T. PROJECT IN 2026 WHICH WOULD TURN THE INTERSECTION OF HWY. 12&18, OAK PARK RD., AND HWY. W INTO A ROUNDABOUT.

FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS: SOLAR FARM LICENSE ORDINANCE, KOSHKONONG SOLAR FARM, DEER-GROVE EMS STUDY AND RADIO FUND REQUEST.

ON A MOTION BY NICK BRATTLIE, SECONDED BY KATIE MICHEL, THE BOARD ADJOURNED AT 7:45 P.M. MOTION CARRIED.
