Christmas Tree Disposal is scheduled at no charge on January 5th and January 12th (your service day), but by a different truck for needed disposal. Residents need to call/contact Badgerland Disposal/LRS to schedule this service by either emailing us at bifownservice disposal or calling to 608-580-0580.

\*\*Requests for tree disposal **after** the listed designated days will result in a \$45.00 charge billed directly to the resident as and added, special pickup will need to be arranged.

#### SERVICE CALENDAR:

Enclosed please find your service calendar which outlines your collection schedule. Trash will be picked up weekly and recycle will be picked up every other week. Service dates are highlighted through color coding based on your address.

### RECYCLING:

Your recycling cart will be serviced **bi-weekly** (every other week) based on the enclosed calendar / schedule for your address. The following items are banned from Wisconsin landfills and as a result should be placed in your recycling cart for proper processing, handling and/or reuse:

- · Aluminum containers
- Bi-metal containers (i.e. containers made from a combination of steel and aluminum)
- Corrugated cardboard (all corrugated cardboard cut into pieces no larger than 3' x 3')
- · Magazines and other materials printed on similar paper
- · Newspaper and other materials printed on newsprint
- Mixed paper
- Plastic containers #1 #7 milk jugs, laundry detergent bottles, soda and water bottles, etc.
   Steel containers (tin cans)

# WASTE (trash, garbage, refuse):

Your trash cart will be serviced **every week** based on the enclosed calendar / schedule for your address. Solid waste is what most of us think of as "trash", "refuse" or "garbage" that is produced at home, work or leisure. This category does NOT include any of the recyclable items listed above, any household hazardous waste, liquid latex paint, yard waste, appliances or electronics.

YARD WASTE NOT ALLOWED (grass clippings, leaves, branches, soil, etc).

Dear Town of Deerfield Residents.

Badgerland Disposal, an LRS Company, is proud to announce new curbside collection service for residents in the Town of Deerfield beginning in January 2022. Badgerland Disposal/LRS will provide recycling and refuse collection for all residents. Under the new curbside collection program, each resident will receive a new 95-gallon poly-cart for their recyclables and a 95-gallon poly-cart for their trash. Customers who prefer a 65 gallon cart size for either trash and/or recyclables should contact our team at Badgerland Disposal/LRS at 608-580-0580 or email to

BEFORE February 1st, 2021 to request alternate size. <u>All containers will be delivered prior to your start date the week of December 20th.</u>

Starting the first full week of Jaunary (see attached calendar), please roll the containers to the end of the driveway on collection day. Please do not use your containers prior to this date. Containers should be placed 3 feet apart & 3 feet from any obstruction, walking between containers is a good rule of thumb. Or, place one container on the left side of the driveway and the other container on the right. Please remember: Bright Bite Lid = Recycle. Your collection day will be Wednesday. Feel free to contact us by calling 608-580-0580 or via email to blownservice or service any questions. Be sure to include your address when communicating with us to help expedite our customer service process with you.

#### COLLECTION PROGRAM GUIDELINES:

- Trash and recycling must be curbside by 6:00 a.m. on your designated collection day,
- · All waste / recycling materials must be INSIDE of the carts, waste or bags outside of the carts will not be taken
- · On holiday weeks we operate on a one-day delay, if the holiday falls on a week day.
- Carts remain the property of Badgerland Disposal/LRS. Residents will be required to pay for replacement carts if damages are due to negligence or abuse,
- Please do not take the containers if you move. You may label the containers with tape or removable decal, but do not
  write on or deface in any other way.

Items that **CANNOT** be placed in the **trash** container: Dirt, sod, concrete, rock, construction or demolition debris, household hazardous waste, banned electronic waste, leaves, grass clippings, hot ashes or flammable materials such as oil, gas or paint, batteries, engine parts or tires.

## SAFE USE AND CART CARE:

- 1. Always have the lid closed to keep rain, snow and animals out,
- 2. Use the handle provided to move the cart, tilt and roll,
- 3. To clean, simply rinse with water and let dry in the sunlight, lid open
- 4. Do not place any unacceptable materials in the cart.

# BULK ITEM SERVICE:

- -Badgerland Disposal will provide bulk item pick-up service monthly as designated on the service calendar.
- -Bulk Items must be called in for scheduling 48 hrs in advance, as some items require special attention.
- -Residents are allowed **3 items per household, per month.** \* Tires off the rim will be collected as Bulky Item Service with a limit of 2 automobile size tires per pickup and counted as one of the three allowable items. Limit of 6 tires per household/per vear.
- -Place item(s) next to your container, so they are visible for the driver.
