THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MIKE SCHLOBOHM AT 7:00 P.M. WITH ALL OFFICIALS IN ATTENDANCE.

ON A MOTION BY RANDY BEHLKE, SECONDED BY DAN KELLY, THE MEETING AGENDA WAS APPROVED. MOTION CARRIED.

ON A MOTION BY RANDY BEHLKE, SECONDED BY KATIE MICHEL, THE MINUTES OF THE SEPTEMBER MONTHLY MEETING, 09-13-2021, AND THE SPECIAL MEETING, 09-20-2021, WERE APPROVED. MOTION CARRIED.

ZONING PETITION #11739 FOR SOLON PIERCE III WAS TABLED.

ON A MOTION BY KATIE MICHEL, SECONDED BY MIKE SCHLOBOHM, ZONING PETITION #11753 FOR RAY GROB WAS APPROVED. MOTION CARRIED.

TIM LAUGHLIN WAS PRESENT AT THE MEETING TO GIVE THE TOWN AN UPDATE FOR THE FUTURE DEVELOPMENT OF LANDS LOCATED SOUTHEASTERLY OF THE CORNER OF STATE HWY. 73 AND INTERSTATE 94. TOPICS DISCUSSED WERE THE COMBINATION OF OTHER LANDS WITH THE PROPOSAL AND OWNERSHIP OF THE OLD HWY. 73 ROADBED.

JIM MAPLE MADE A SHORT PRESENTATION TO THE BOARD THAT THE TOWN SHOULD CONSIDER MAP "C" FOR THE REDISTRICTING OF LEGISLATIVE AND SUPERVISORY DISTRICTS WITHIN DANE COUNTY. NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.

MIKE SCHLOBOHM INFORMED THE BOARD THAT MUNSON BLACKTOPPING WOULD BE DOING SOME BLACKTOP WEDGING AND PATCHING PROJECTS ON VARIOUS TOWN ROADS IN THE UPCOMING DAYS.

THE DEER-GROVE EMS WOULD BE PRESENTING SOME DETAILS OF ITS STUDY FOR FUTURE NEEDS AND DIRECTION BY THE END OF THE YEAR.

ON A MOTION BY NICK BRATTLIE, SECONDED BY RANDY BEHLKE, APPROVAL WAS GIVEN TO THE TREASURER'S REPORT AND A GENERAL FUND VOUCHER OF \$707,786.48. MOTION CARRIED.
