

TOWN OF DEERFIELD

MONTHLY MEETING, MONDAY, FEBRUARY 14, 2022, 7:00 P.M., DCC CENTER, 10 LIBERTY ST.

CHAIRMAN MIKE SCHLOBOHM CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AT 7:00 P.M. WITH ALL OFFICERS EXCEPT FOR SUPERVISORS RANDY BEHLKE AND NICK BRATTLIE PRESENT.

ON A MOTION BY DAN KELLY, SECONDED BY KATIE MICHEL, THE BOARD AGREED TO THE MEETING ADOPTION AS POSTED. MOTION CARRIED.

ON A MOTION BY KATIE MICHEL, SECONDED BY MIKE SCHLOBOHM, THE BOARD APPROVED THE JANUARY MINUTES. MOTION CARRIED.

DISCUSSION CENTERED REGARDING THE FUTURE DEVELOPMENT OF LANDS AROUND THE SOUTH OF THE INTERSECTION OF STATE HWY. 73 AND INTERSTATE 94. MR. TIM LOUGHLIN WAS PRESENT TO INFORM THE BOARD OF HIS PARTNERSHIP WITH ANOTHER PROPERTY OWNER TO OFFER APPROXIMATELY 20 ACRES FOR COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT. THE BRIDGE AND INTERSECTION WITH POSSIBLE ROUND-A-BOUNTS IS SCHEDULED FOR RECONSTRUCTION IN 2025. NO FURTHER ACTION WAS TAKEN.

MR. JEFF MOERKE WAS PRESENT TO INFORM THE BOARD OF INTENTIONS TO CORRECT TRAFFIC FLOW PROBLEMS ON STATE HWY. 73 AT EVENTS HELD ON HIS FARM FOR 2022 AND BEYOND. NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.

MR. SCOTT MILLER WAS PRESENT TO REQUEST THE BOARD VACATE THE DRIVEWAY WHICH IS A TOWN ROAD AT THE NORTHERN POINT OF N. FAIR OAK RD. HE ALSO PRESENTED THE IDEA OF REPLACING THE STOP SIGN WITH A YIELD SIGN. THE BOARD INFORMED MR. MILLER THAT A YIELD SIGN WOULD NOT BE POSSIBLE AND AS THE TOWN ROAD/DRIVEWAY SERVED TWO PARTIES, BOTH PARTIES WOULD HAVE TO AGREE TO HAVE THE ROAD VACATED BY THE TOWNSHIP. NO FURTHER ACTION WAS TAKEN.

THE BOARD REVIEWED ORDINANCE NO. 2022-01 SOLAR FARM LICENSE ORDINANCE. ON A MOTION BY DAN KELLY, SECONDED BY MIKE SCHLOBOHM, THE BOARD AGREED TO HAVE THE ORDINANCE ON THE MARCH AGENDA FOR FINAL APPROVAL. MOTION CARRIED.

MR. ERIC LANG, DEER-GROVE EMS, WAS PRESENT TO UPDATE THE BOARD ON THE FINAL REPORT FOR FUTURE STAFFING NEEDS TO HAVE A SECOND AMBULANCE AVAILABLE 24/7, THE RADIO FUNDING REQUEST, AND THE COMPLETION OF A NEW AMBULANCE IN JUNE.

ON A MOTION BY KATIE MICHEL, SECONDED BY MIKE SCHLOBOHM, THE BOARD APPROVED THE TREASURER'S REPORT AND A GENERAL FUND VOUCHER OF \$29,304.78. MOTION CARRIED.

THE BOARD DECIDED TO ALLOW FOR MORE TIME TO BE ALLOWED FOR THE NEW GARBAGE COLLECTION AGENCY, BADGERLAND DISPOSAL, IN WORKING OUT SOME PROBLEMS BETWEEN RESIDENTS COLLECTIONS, MISSED ROADS, ETC.

THE BOARD INFORMED THE CLERK TO SEND A CERTIFIED LETTER TO GFL ENVIRONMENTAL REQUESTING THEM TO PICK UP THEIR APPROXIMATELY 75 CONTAINERS AT THE TOWN GARAGE WITH A CREDIT AMOUNT IN ORDER TO BE PAID FOR THEIR LAST MONTH OF SERVICE 12-31-2021.

IN CORRESPONDENCE, MIKE SCHLOBOHM INFORMED THE BOARD THAT THERE WOULD BE NO FIREMEN'S FESTIVAL FOR 2022.
