MONTHLY MEETING, MONDAY, MARCH 14, 2022, 7:00 P.M., DCC CENTER, 10 LIBERTY ST.

ALL OFFICERS EXCEPT SUPERVISOR K. MICHEL WERE PRESENT.

ON A MOTION BY RANDY BEHLKE, SECONDED BY MIKE SCHLOBOHM, THE MEETING AGENDA WAS APPROVED. MOTION CARRIED.

ON A MOTION BY DAN KELLY, SECONDED BY MIKE SCHLOBOHM, THE FEBRUARY MEETING MINUTES WERE APPROVED. MOTION CARRIED.

ROXANNE ENGELSTAD, REPRESENTING LIBERTY LUTHERAN CURCH, WAS PRESENT TO PUBLICLY THANK THE TOWN WORKERS FOR CLEARING THE SNOW DURING A FUNERAL FOR MRS. H. KELLER.

MR. STEVEN SCHULTZ WAS PRESENT TO INTRODUCE HIMSELF AS A CANDIDATE FOR DANE COUNTY SUPERVISOR DISTRICT 37 IN THE UPCOMING APRIL ELECTION.

MR. ERIC LANG, REPRESENTATIVE FOR DEER-GROVE EMS, WAS PRESENT TO GIVE A SHORT REPORT AS TO THE FINANCIAL CONDITION OF THE SERVICE, THE PROGRESS UPDATE FOR THE NEW AMBULANCE, AND THE FUNDING REQUEST FOR NEW RADIOS.

ON A MOTION BY RANDY BEHLKE, SECONDED BY DAN KELLY, A MOTION WAS MADE TO ADOPT SOLAR FARM ORDINANCE 2022-01. MOTION CARRIED.

ON A MOTION BY RANDY BEHLKE, SECONDED BY NICK BRATTLIE, THE BOARD REFERRED BACK TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION FOR FURTHER INPUT THE QUESTIONS OF PREFERRED ROUTING FOR CONSTRUCTION TRAFFIC AND THE BOND AMOUNT FOR ROAD DAMAGES BY INVENERGY DURING THE CONSTRUCTION PHASE OF THE SOLAR FARM. MOTION CARRIED.

ON A MOTION BY RANDY BEHLKE, SECONDED BY NICK BRATTLIE, THE BOARD ADOPTED THE 2022 MINING APPLICATION FOR FOREVER SAND & GRAVEL. MOTION CARRIED. ALL SUPERVISORS WERE IN FAVOR EXCEPT FOR M. SCHLOBOHM WHO ABSTAINED.

ON A MOTION BY RANDY BEHLKE, SECONDED BY NICK BRATTLIE, THE BOARD PASSES REZONE #11816 FOR J. MORSCHAUSER SEPARATING FARM BUILDINGS.MOTION CARRIED.

ON A MOTION BY RANDY BEHLKE, SECONDED BY DAN KELLY, THE BOARD PASSED REZONE #11815 SHIFTING BOUNDARY LINES AROUND THE B. BIERMEIER PROPERTY. MOTION CARRIED.
