MEETING, SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 16, 2025, 3:00 P.M., TOWN GARAGE, 838 LONDON ROAD

THE MEETING TO DISCUSS THE FIVE BIDS FOR THE PROPOSED NEW TOWN HALL BEGAN AT 3:00 P.M. WITH KATIE MICHEL, RANDY BEHLKE, DAN KELLY AND BOB RIEGE ATTENDING. TRAVIS LESSOR, REPRESENTATIVE FOR CLEARY BUILDINGS WAS ALSO IN ATTENDANCE.

IT WAS DECIDED TO SET ASIDE THE BIDS OF BAUER & RAETHER BUILDERS AND DANIELS CONSTRUCTION AS THESE WERE THE HIGHEST BIDS.

DISCUSSION THEN CENTERED ON THE PROS AND CONS OF THE THREE REMAINING BIDS OF CLEARY BUILDINGS (\$450,000.00), CORPORATE CONTRACTORS (\$508,278.96) AND HARMONY CONSTRUCTION (\$542,828.00).

RANDY BEHLKE MADE A MOTION TO MOVE FORWARD WITH THE BID OF CLEARY BUILDINGS FOR CONSIDERATION OF THE FULL TOWN BOARD AT THE MARCH MEETING. KATIE MICHEL AND DAN KELLY AGREED TO THE MOTION. THE FINAL VERSION IF APPROVED AT THE MARCH MEETING WOULD BE PRESENTED TO THE ELECTORS AT THE ANNUAL MEETING IN APRIL.
