

## RESOLUTION 2025-01

### REVOCATION OF ORDINANCE 2020-03 PERTAINING TO THE TOWN OF DEERFIELD CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT PROCESS AND PROCEDURES


**WHEREAS** The Town of Deerfield recognized that the Wisconsin Legislative Act 67 added rules for processing Conditional Use Permits (CUP) that required a “quasi-judicial” process for reviewing CUPs and adopted Ordinance 2020-03 to meet these requirements.

**WHEREAS** The Dane County Board of Supervisors on April 10, 2025 approved amending Chapter 10 of the Dane County Code of Ordinances, regarding the review process for Conditional Use Permits.

**WHEREAS** The Town of Deerfield presently only has an advisory role in the approval process of CUPs and Dane County has assumed the responsibility of conducting public hearings and reviewing CUP applications in accordance with Act 67.


